#### Instructions:

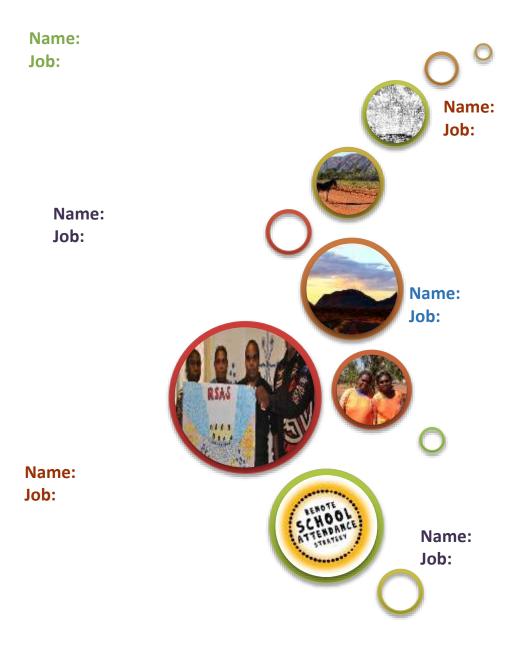
- □ Form a circle.

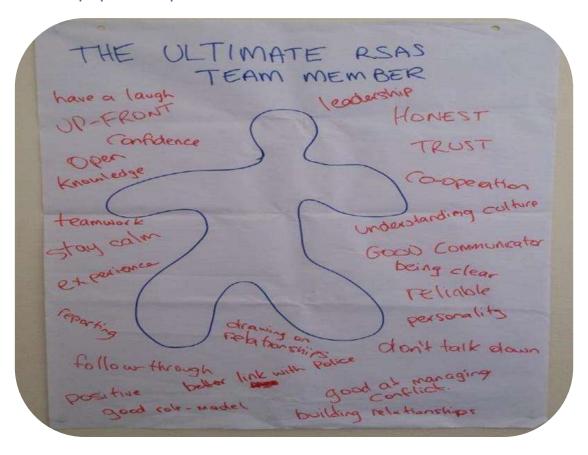
